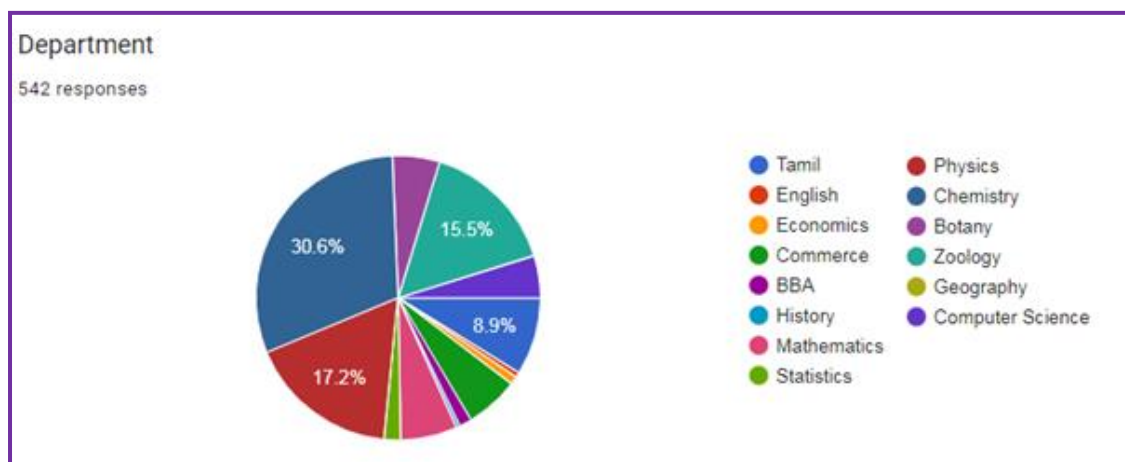

Questionnaire were sent in Google forms through the link

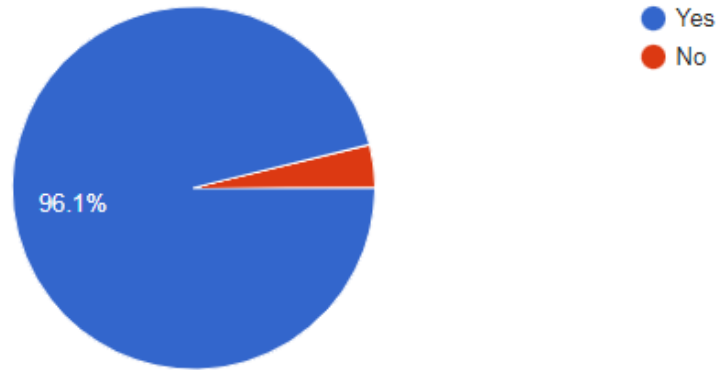

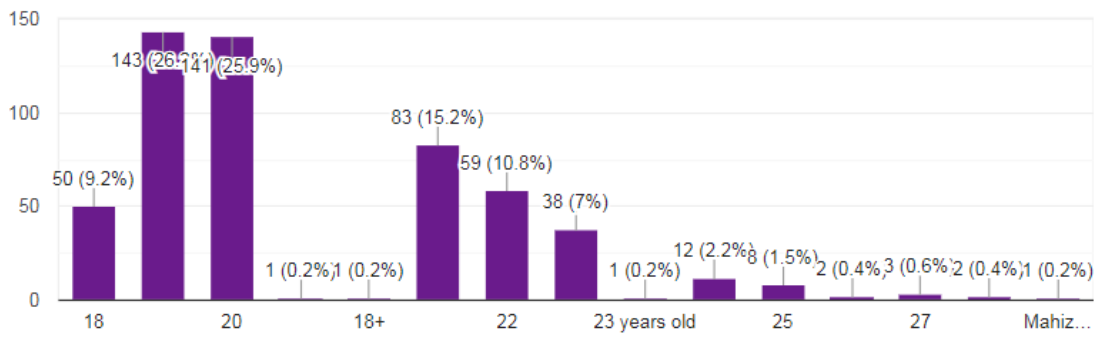

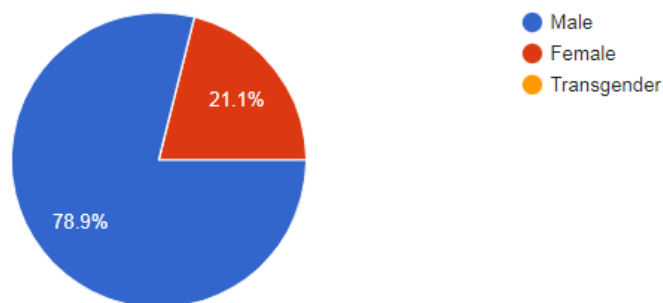
B) Age

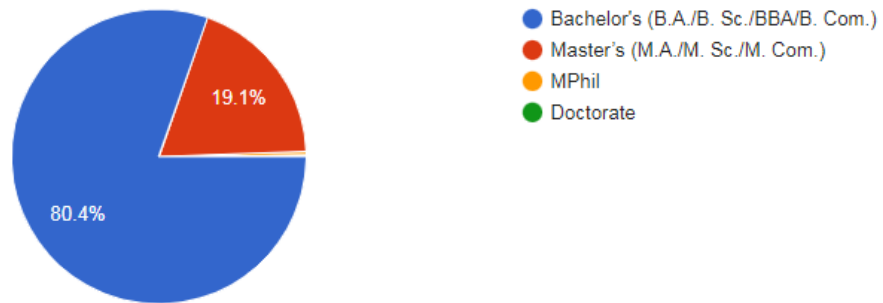
C) Gender

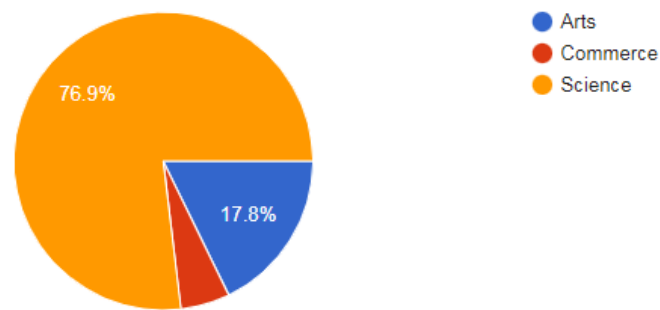
D) What degree program are you pursuing now?

E) What subject area are you pursuing?

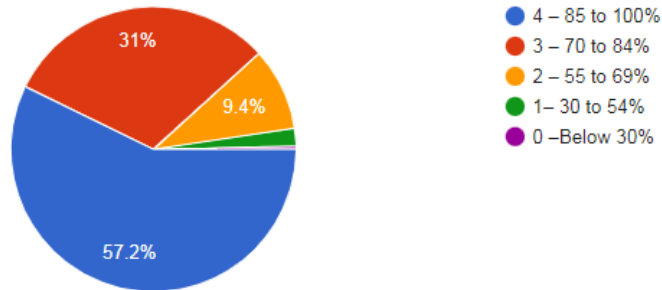

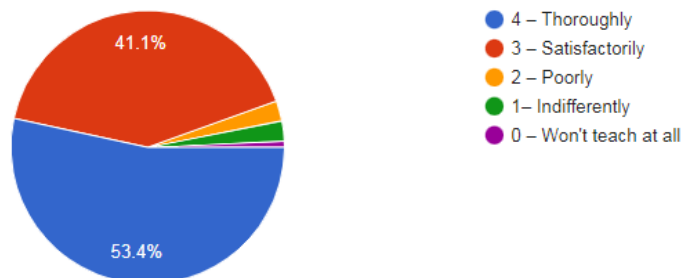


Observation:

Students Feedback Report shows that majority of the syllabus was covered through online classes and the remaining syllabus was covered through physical classes during lockdown period.

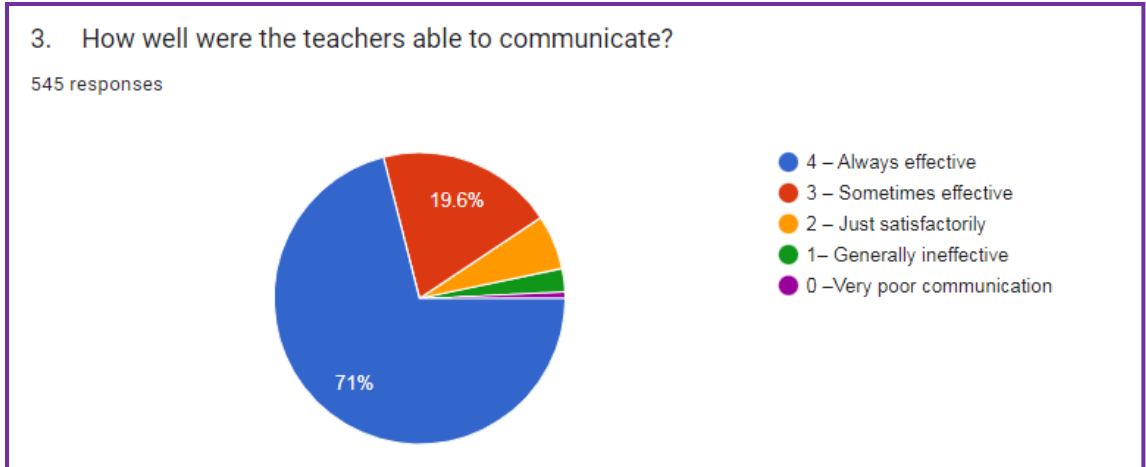
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

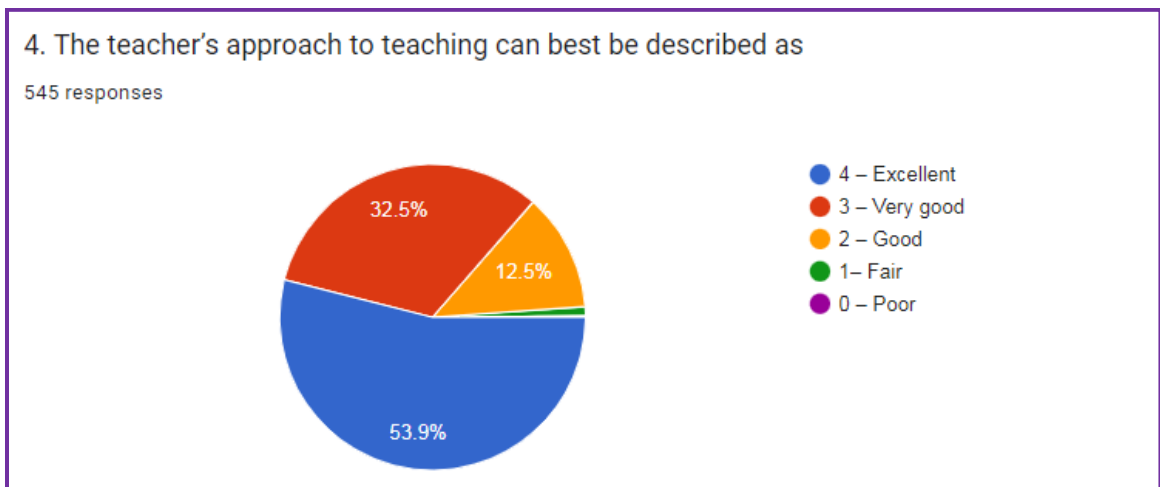
Observation:

A Total of **53.4 %** students answered that teachers prepare very well for the classes.



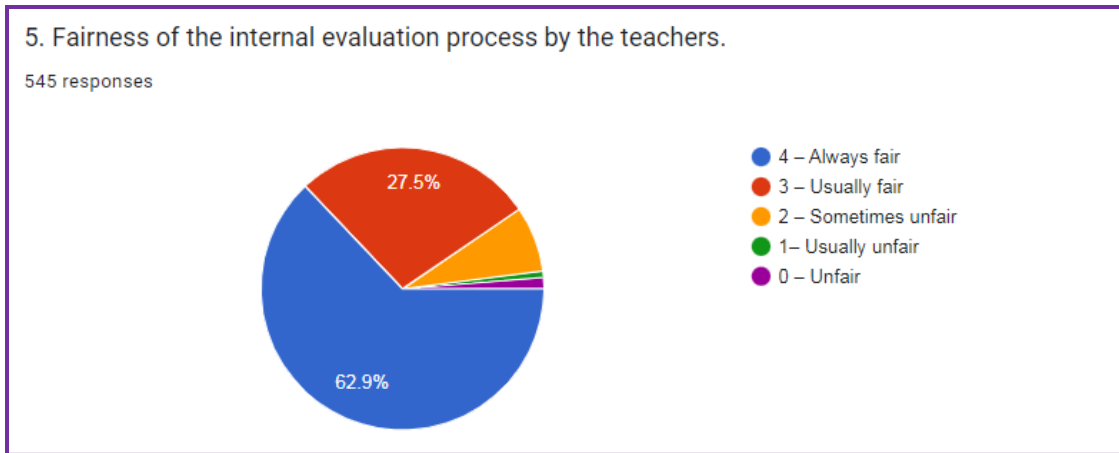
Observation:

A Total of **71 %** students accept that teachers communicate very well with students.



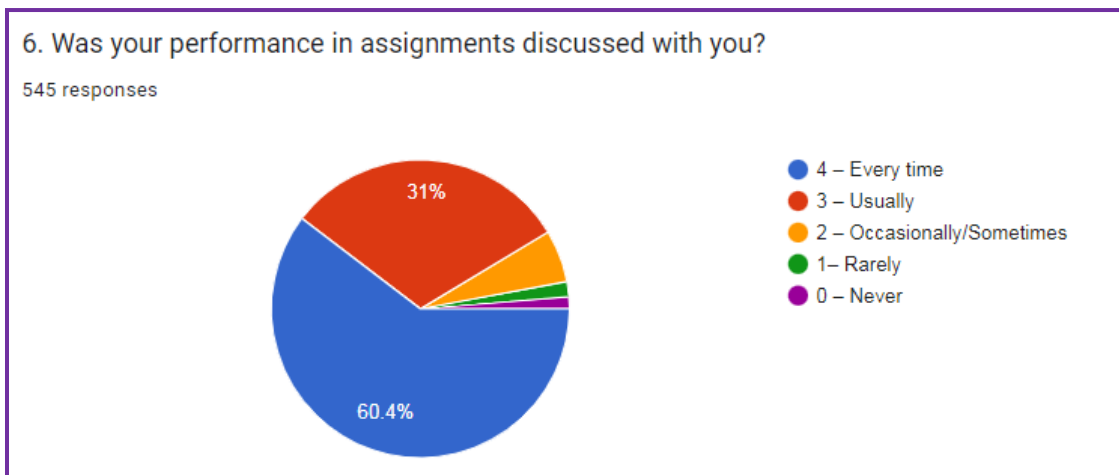
Observation:

A Total of **62.9 %** students believe that the internal evaluation process is usually fair and transparental.

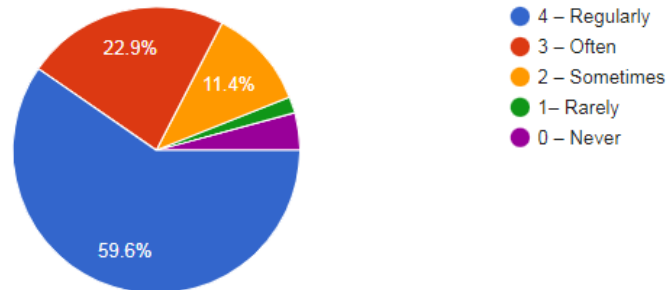


Observation:

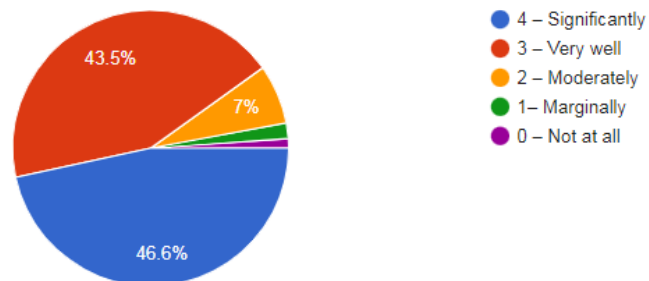

A Total of **59.6 %** students admit that institute takes initiative in promoting internships, student exchange & field visits for students.

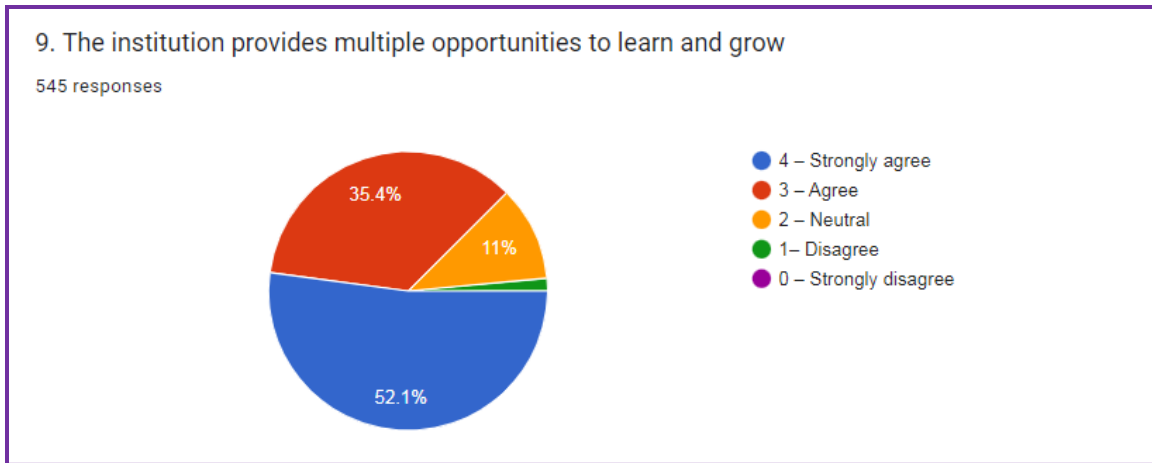
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

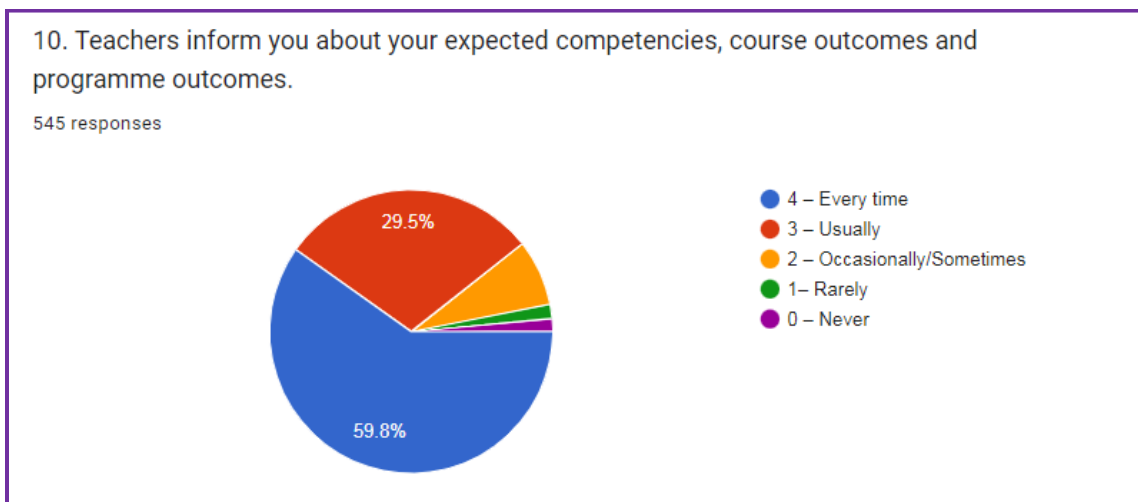
Observation:

A Total of **46.6 %** students believe that the teaching and mentoring process in the institute facilitates to their overall growth.



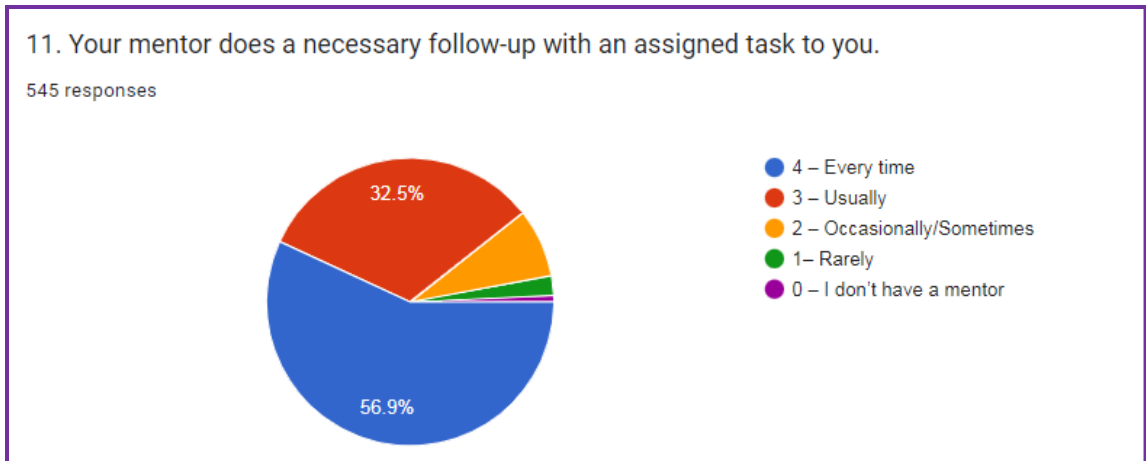
Observation:

A Total of **52.1 %** students hold that many more opportunities are provided by the institution to learn & grow.



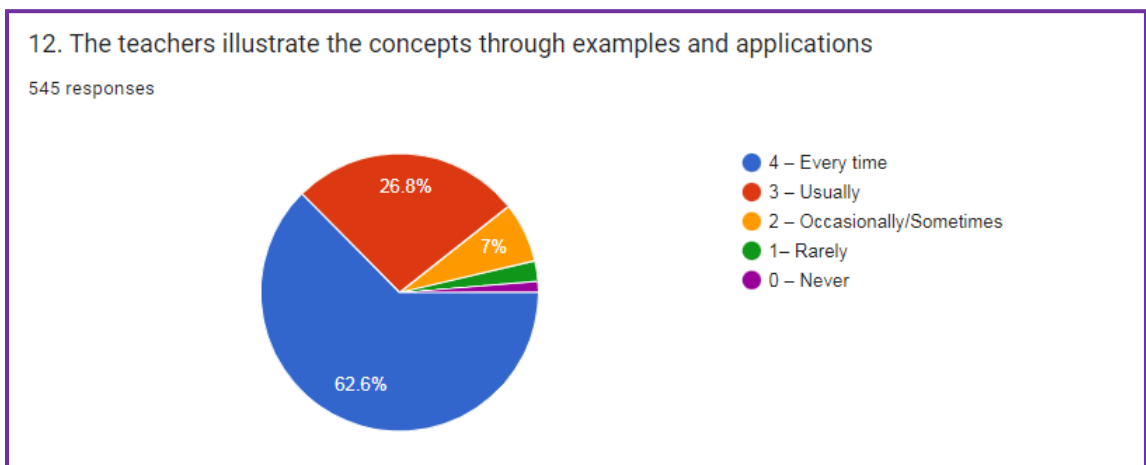
Observation:

A Total of **59.8 %** students believe that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes most of the times.



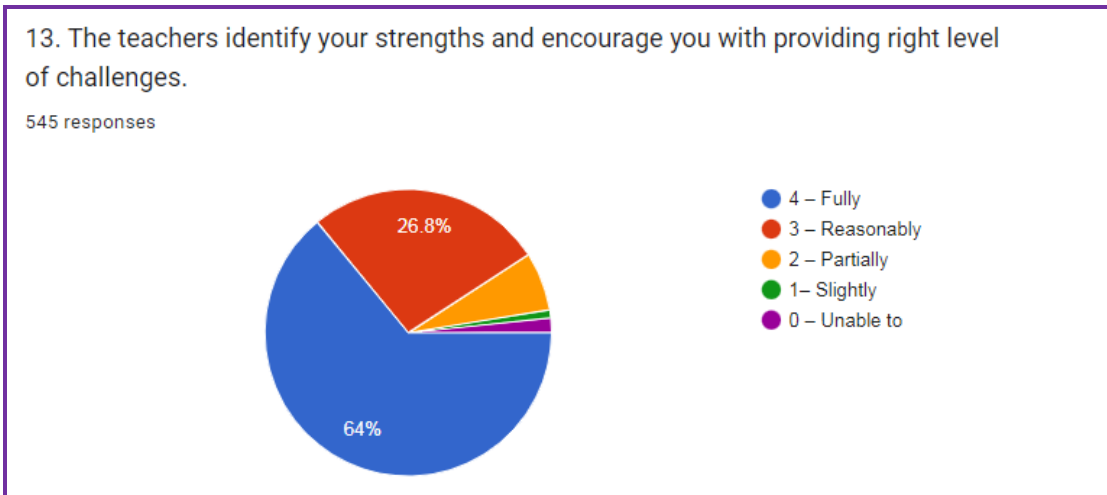
Observation:

A Total of **62.6 %** students consider that while teaching teacher illustrates the concepts through examples and applications almost all the times.

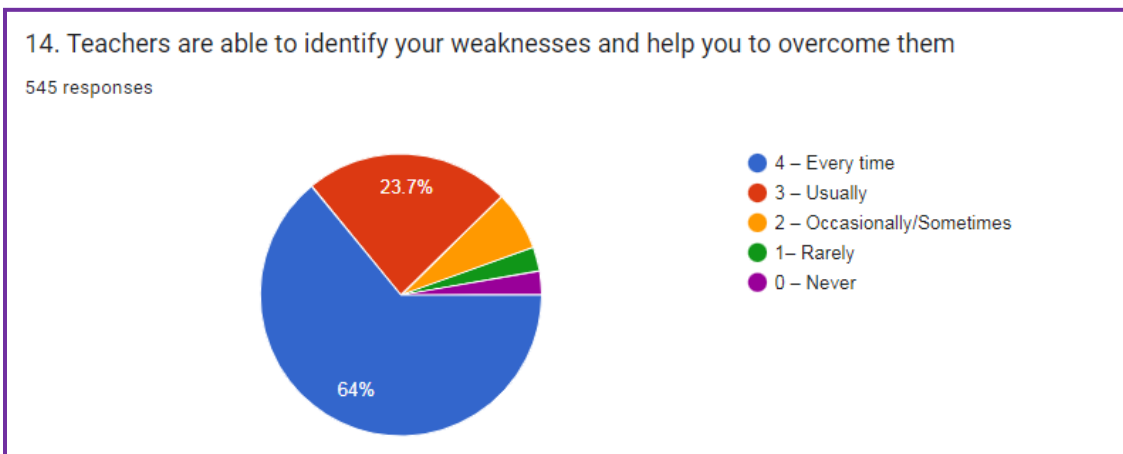


Observation:

Individual care and regular motivation.

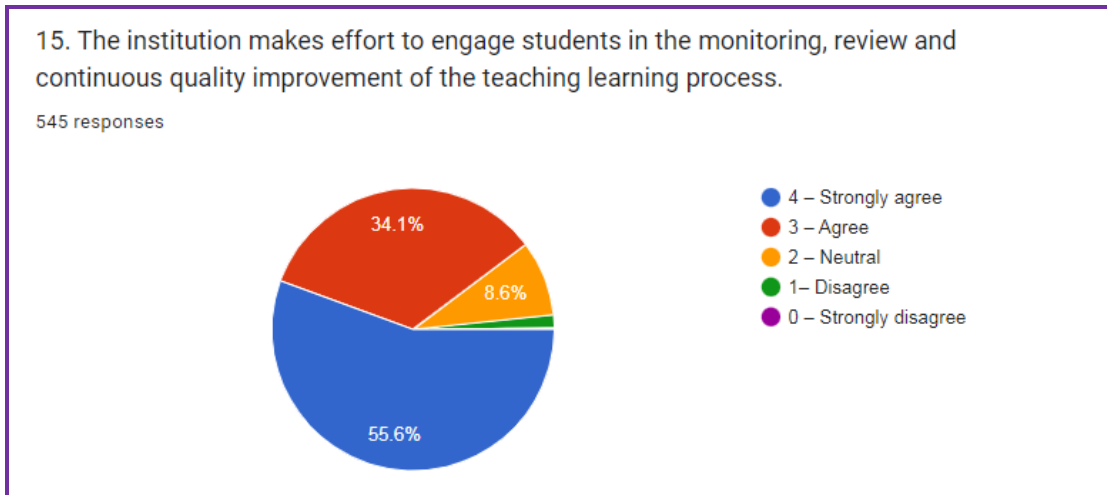


Observation:

A Total of **64 %** students believe that teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help them to overcome their weakness.

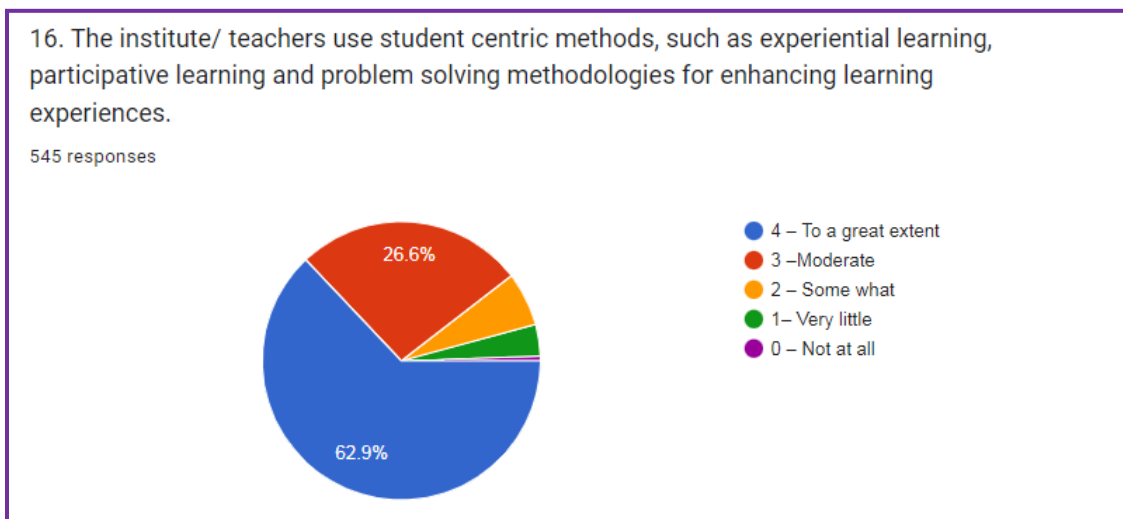
Action Taken:

Identifying weakness and assisting personally to overcome it.



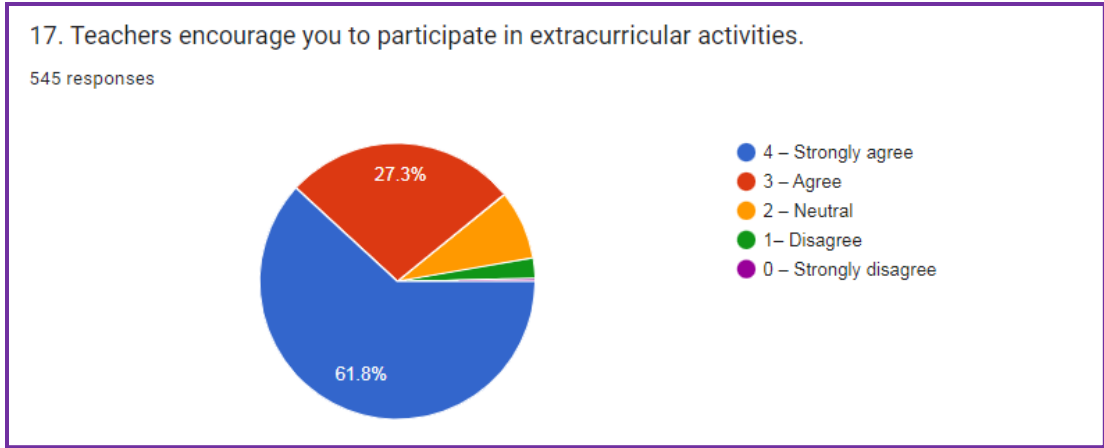
Observation:

A Total of **55.6 %** students are agree that institute makes effort to engage students in the Monitoring, review & continuous assessment of their teaching learning process.



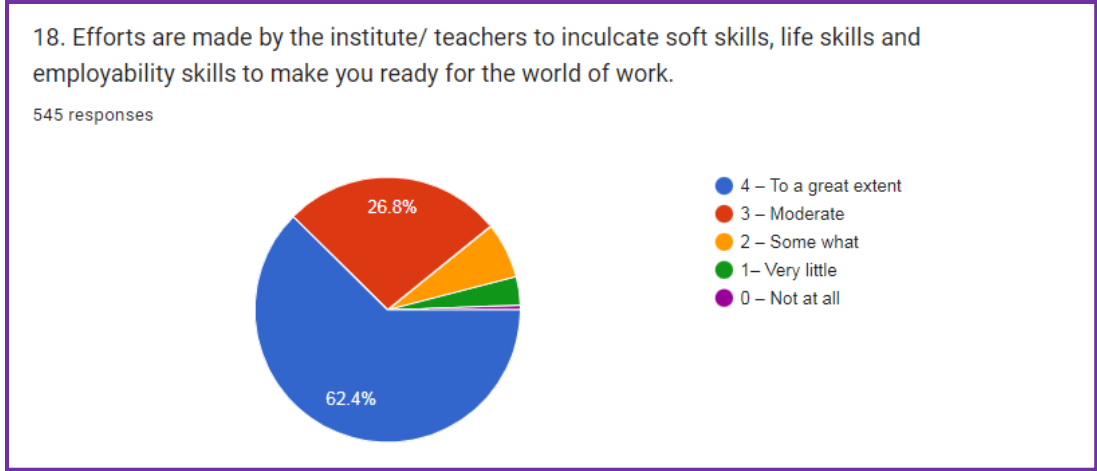

A Total of **62.9 %** students admit that teachers use student centric methods in their teaching methodology for the benefits of the students.



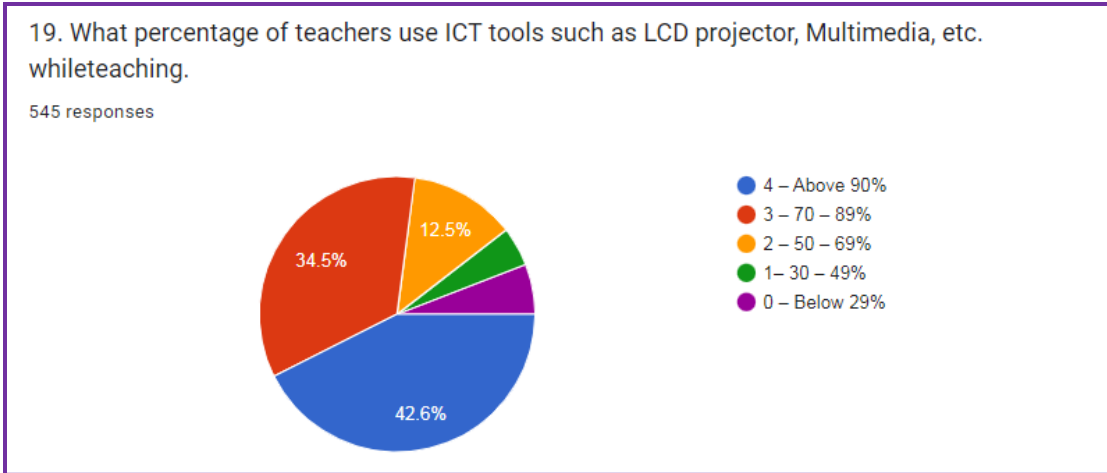
Observation:

A Total of **61.8 %** students answered that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities in their interested field.



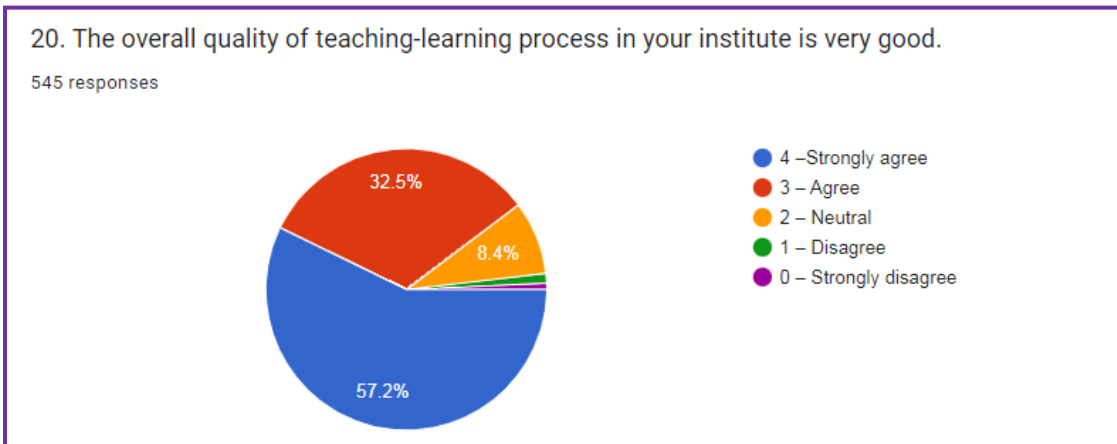
Observation:
